Our ghoulish guests also enjoyed "pencils, stickers and comics, oh my!" for added treats.



# **YNL Multi-Media Club bring ghosts to life with film project**



Just in time for Halloween, the YN Library Multi-Media Club completed their latest video project titled, “Bothered”.

The short horror film depicts a fictional paranormal investigation conducted by the multi-media club members.

Filmed inside of the YN Library, the “paranormal investigation team” tour the alleged haunting hot-spots and give backstories to each of the locations.

The team then set up two stationary cameras to try to capture evidence. When they return, it is confirmed that there are more than books occupying the library.

Shot in early October, “Bothered”, uses the found-footage filming approach that horror movie hits such as “Paranormal Activity” and “The Blair Witch Project” revolutionized.

Like those films, the actors (in this case, the club members) were given a loose script idea and were provided with no dialogue.

This technique, called Retroscribing, allows the actors to improvise most of their lines to add realism to the performances.

The jump-scares the team encounter in the film were unbeknownst to them, adding more realism.

The short film premiered at the Yakama Nation Theatre on October 28<sup>th</sup>, just before the theatre’s scheduled feature film. It was shown again on Halloween.



## FIND A LOST PHONE with Android's Device Manager

We have all occasionally lost track of a phone. Maybe it was hiding in the couch cushions or sitting on the kitchen counter.

Don't go crazy looking for your phone next time, just use Android Device Manager. You can access this via the web on a mobile device or computer.



Simply log into your Google account, and choose your missing phone from the drop down. Google reaches out and shows you where it is.

You can also ring the phone, even if it's in silent mode.

If worse comes to worse, you can remotely erase the phone to protect your data.


