Assists cleaning crew to keep school grounds and buildings safe and clean

**Examples of Work Performed:**

- Attends to Yakama Nation Tribal School grounds. Cuts lawn twice a week in summertime; Picks up trash in parking lot; sweeps and cleans patio; uses weed eater as needed; and changes light bulbs.
- Cleans Tribal School bathrooms, wash mirrors, unclogs toilet and sinks, refills paper towels and soap dispensers.
- Cleans Tribal School lunchroom. Puts away tables and chairs after meals and takes out the garbage.
- Cleans Tribal School floors. Scrubs classrooms and hallway floors; uses burnishing machine to shine floors.
- Changes light switches, wall plugs, ballast, and heater motors as needed.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Must have basic working knowledge of electrical, plumbing, and carpentry functions.
- Must have basic working knowledge of air conditioning and heating systems.
- Must have working knowledge of BIA guidelines applicable to grant schools.
- Must have working knowledge of safety guidelines, including those applicable to the disabled.

**General Recruiting Indicators:**

- Minimum of High School Diploma or Equivalent. Must be in good physical condition. Have at least 1-year custodial experience.

**Special Requirements:**

- Possession of or the ability to obtain a valid Washington State Driver's License, with ability to obtain a Yakama Nation Tribal Driver's Permit.
- Ability to complete background check according to Yakama Nation Tribal School requirements.
- Must have auto Insurance.
- Must have First Aid/CPR certification.
