Responsible to provide Mental Health Services and consultation for children and families identified as requiring counseling Coordinates with other key school staff, mental health staff, and/or collaborative agencies to develop individual treatment plans.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of the basic principles, practices and professional standards of providing clinical mental health services to tribal communities.
- Knowledge of behavior techniques to modify behaviors of identified children.
- Knowledge of Special Education policies, 504 Plans and Individual Education Plans and contributing as a professional on behalf of the child.
- Knowledge of Yakama Nation Personnel Policies.
- Knowledge and proficiency in computer use.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other department staff, supervisors/managers and the public.
- Ability to prepare accurate, comprehensive and detailed reports and correspondence.
- Ability to meet the public and address problems, issues and complaints tactfully, courteously and effectively.

General Recruiting Indicators:

- Master's Degree in Education and/or Social Work and one year of related clinical experience working with children and families in a school setting.
- Must have associate/affiliate status through Washington State Department of Health. Full licensure must be acquired within the time frame established by the Department of Health and Director.

Special Requirements:

- Required to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
- Required to pass a pre-employment background check.
- No drug/alcohol abuse offenses within the past two years.
- Enrolled Yakama preference.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver's License.
- This position normally requires physical demands of standing, walking, bending, lifting or performing other work requiring low physical exertion, talking and hearing on a regular basis to perform the job requirements. These physical demands are required up to 20% of the time. Position also requires ability to drive with adequate vision.
