Responsible for the maintenance of electrical, plumbing and water system, buildings and grounds for the Yakama Nation.

**Example of Work Performed:**

- Paint maintenance of buildings.
- Roof work in the maintenance of buildings.
- Maintenance of the grounds for various buildings/sites.
- Maintenance of utility systems for various sites.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:**

- Knowledge of standard methods, materials, tools and equipment of one or more of building/electrical trades.
- Knowledge of the occupational hazards and safety precautions necessary in general building maintenance work.
- Skill in the use and care of tools, materials and equipment applicable to work assignments.
- Ability to perform semi-skilled, skilled work in one or more trades.
- Ability to understand and execute oral and written instructions.

**General Recruiting Indicators:**

- High School Diploma or GED and any experience or education that demonstrates the ability to perform the work outlined.

**Special Requirements:**

- Required to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
- Required to pass a pre-employment background check.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver's License and have the ability to obtain a valid Yakama Nation Tribal Driver's Permit.
- Must be in good physical health and have the ability to stand for long periods of time, stoop, climb, and bend in order to execute required tasks of the position.
- Must be able to work indoors or outdoors in all weather conditions which could be severe cold or heat.
