Wildlife Technician V (Habitat)

The position will require work as a member of the Wildlife Habitat Crew coordinating and planning work activity, equipment and general operations of the Program's efforts in enhancing wildlife lands in the valley portion of the Yakama Reservation. Will oversee all activities of the Habitat Crew and be responsible for the completion of all Habitat Crew tasks in a timely manner. Crew tasks involve the operation and maintenance of agricultural equipment, heavy machinery, and hand tools. The position will be involved in activities that require coordination with Yakama Nation Programs, other governmental agencies, private contractors, and the general public (both Yakama and non-Yakama).

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to independently implement and coordinate all aspects of bison management.
- Knowledge and experience in crop farming and ranching practices.
- Ability to work outdoors in a variety of difficult climatic conditions.
- Experience with operation and maintenance of heavy machinery, farm equipment, and four-wheel drive vehicles.
- Ability to work with a wide variety of individuals.

Minimum Requirements:

- An AA degree in relative field.
- Four years work experience as a Wildlife Technician IV or related position.
- Two years of experience in work crew supervision.
- Required to pass pre-employment drug test.
- Yakama enrolled preference, but all qualified applicants are encouraged to apply.
- The incumbent must have experience in the operation and maintenance of heavy machinery and farm equipment.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Commercial Driver's License with the ability to obtain a Yakama Nation Driving Permit.

Preferred Requirements:

- Bachelors Degree in relative field.
