This position will have responsibility for supporting direct treatment to those children and families that qualify for mental health services. This process will include assisting in the family systems assessment, diagnosis, developing a formal treatment plan and providing the indicated treatment. It will also involve significant collaboration with other professionals that may also be providing services to the family.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of the basic principles, practices, and professional standards of providing clinical mental health services to tribal communities.
- Knowledge of the Yakama Nation Personnel Policies.
- Knowledge and proficiency in computer use.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other department staff, supervisors/managers and the public.
- Ability to prepare accurate, comprehensive and detailed reports and correspondence.
- Ability to meet the public and address problems, issues, and complaints tactfully, courteously and effectively.

General Recruiting Indicators:

- Master's Degree in Behavioral Science and 1-year of related clinical experience working with children and families.
- Must have associate/affiliate status through Washington State Department of Health. Full licensure must be acquired within the time frame established by the Department of Health and Director.

Special Requirements:

- Required to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test.
- Required to complete a pre-employment background check.
- Must be licensed as a Mental Health Counselor with the State of Washington.
- Enrolled Yakama Preference.
- Must possess a valid Washington State Driver License.
- No Drug/Alcohol abuse offenses for the past two years.
- This position normally requires physical demands of standing, walking, bending, lifting, or performing other work requiring low physical exertion, talking and hearing on a regular basis to perform the job requirements. These physical demand are required up to 80% of the time. Position also requires ability to drive with adequate vision.
