Deadline for fall term/academic year is July 1st. November 1st for Winter Quarter/Spring Semester. February 1st for spring quarter and May 1st for High School seniors who want their awards announced at their high school graduation and those who qualify for summer funding. Summer funding will only be granted to students who need it to graduate or in a program that requires you to maintain full time status year round such as the medical programs. High School seniors who miss the May 1st deadline can still meet the July 1st deadline.
